Dos and Don'ts for students for online classes (Google Meet):

Before the Class

- 1. Be prepared for the class with a notebook, the textbook as per the schedule, pen, pencils, and other stationery as required for the class.
- 2. Charge the devices (laptop/iPad/tab/mobile) fully, to be used for the class beforehand.
- 3. Ensure the internet connection is adequate to support the learning process.

During the Class

- 4. Greet the teacher at the start of your class.
- 5. Join the class regularly and on time.
- 6. Attend the class in a place where there is no background noise/disturbance.
- 7. Switch on the video camera to join the online class.
- 8. Dress according to the norms of the class.
- 9. Consistently follow the rules and regulations of the class.
- 10. Listen and follow the cues and the instructions given by the teachers during the online class.
- 11. Turn off your microphones until and unless you have a doubt to clarify or you have been asked to speak by the teacher.
- 12. Do not use any profane language during the class sessions while answering a question verbally or chatting through the chat box present in Google Meet.
- 13. Do not spam the chat box by typing irrelevant messages. Do not use the chat box unless the teacher instructs you to use it.
- 14. Do not argue or pass derogatory comments about your peers during the class.
- 15. If any student is found guilty of indulging in undisciplined behaviour during the online classes s/he will be removed from the class permanently.

After the Class

- 16. Complete the assignments and post it before the deadline.
- 17. Revise the concepts taught for the day at least once, before you go to bed.
- 18. Watch the videos shared for reinforcement by the teachers.
