#### **GETTING STARTED**




2. The online classes for your children will be implemented using the apps provided by Google Education. Google Education is a safe and user friendly platform for both the student as well as the teacher.

### SETTING UP YOUR GOOGLE ACCOUNT

 Access the present google account in your preferred desktop or PC and click on the "Add another account" provision.



• The following screen will request you to enter your Google Id and password. You must enter the ID and Password allotted by school. Please note that you must enter the complete ID and password in the same manner provided by the school.



Once your Google account has been setup, you will be able to access the online classes, worksheets and all other activities part of the online curriculum.


The online classes will consist of two components:

- A virtual live interaction platform for students and teachers. This will be carried out through the Google Meet platform. Students and teachers will meet via google meet for a limited period of time for a productive and effective teaching and learning interactions. The time table for which will be communicated to you via ParentApp.
- 2. A virtual classroom to track students work and progress. This will be carried out through the Google Classroom platform. The students will receive worksheets and reinforcement resources to aid in the learning process. Teachers will view all student work to track their progress in real time. The worksheets have been created using the Google Jamboards application.

**STEP 1** – You will receive an email invite to the google classroom, to your official email ID. Please click on the join link, it will redirect you to the google classroom.






## JOINING YOUR VIRTUAL CLASSROOM




STEP 2 - Open your google classroom and you will see a google meet link.



**Step 3:** The Hangout meet link will redirect you to the page given below. Click on join now to join the meeting






### **ACCESSING THE ONLINE WORKSHEETS**


The online worksheets have been created using the Document, PDF and Forms application.

**STEP 1** – Click on the worksheet posted by the teacher.






STEP 2 – The following screen will appear. Click on the worksheet appearing on the right side.




- **STEP 3** The worksheet will open in a new tab. The worksheet has been created on by using google forms, pdfs or Word documents.
- **STEP 4** Once back in the Classroom page, click on the Turn in option to submit the completed worksheet to your teacher. You may post a private comment if necessary. Add or create option will allow you to upload the edited files and answer sheets.





Once the teacher has checked your worksheet, you will be notified by the Classroom application. Click on the worksheet to check the teacher feedback and private comment.
