Important Instructions

1. Candidates who wish to appear in the Second Board Examination, but whose names were not submitted during the First Phase of LOC, may now submit their names and pay the examination fee of Rs. 320 per subject (to school account) on or before 17/4/26
 2. Candidates whose names were submitted during the First Phase may now pay the examination fee of Rs. 320 per subject (to school account) on or before 17/4/26
 3. Candidates who had submitted their names earlier but do not wish to appear in the Second Examination may withdraw their names.
 4. Candidates may also change Mathematics option in the Second Board Examination:
 - Students who offered Mathematics Standard) in the Main Examination may opt for Mathematics (Basic) in the Second Examination.
 - Students who offered Mathematics (Basic) may opt for Mathematics (Standard).
 - Change of other offered subjects are not allowed.
 - There will not be any change in the schedule and no correction will be allowed after LOC submission is over.
